The Friends of Fort Dupont Ice Arena (Friends of FDIA), a not for profit 501[c]3, was formed in the summer of 1996 in response to the pending closure of the ice arena by its former owner, the National Park Service. Parents and friends organized and took over the management of the arena, revitalizing the facility that is located in the heart of Ward 7 in Southeast DC.

Friends of FDIA went on to create the Kids On Ice® (KOI) program, which provides subsidized figure skating, hockey and speed skating lessons to youth in the Washington DC Metropolitan area. This program is unique in that it introduces children to three Olympic sports, offers programming to both boys and girls, and provides children with the option to choose from either a team sport or an individual sport.

Fun Fact - Fort Dupont Ice Arena is the only public indoor ice arena located in Washington, DC.
